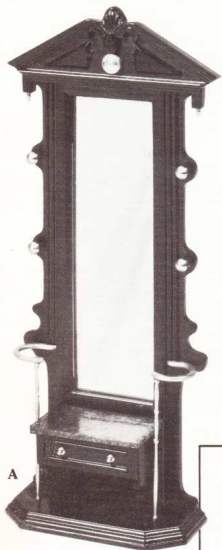
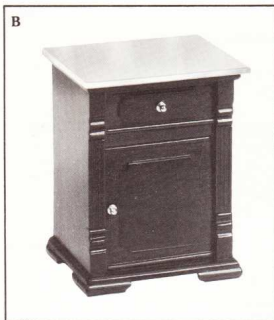


Pre-Crafted Victoriana is Ready to Display

The House of Miniatures offers the Coronation Series — elegantly pre-crafted Victorian miniatures in solid wood. Extravagant ornamentation of each distinctive piece, captures the style of mid 1800 originals in amazing detail.



A. HALL TREE (Style 51019) is reminiscent of a time when there was no such thing as the hall closet. Large brass knobs held coats or hats, brass railings received canes or umbrellas, and carryalls could be left on the marble shelf. c. 1800's. 7 3/4" h x 3 1/2" w x 1 1/4" d. **HOM Finished.** #999ME \$39.95

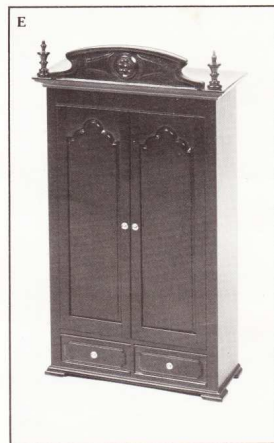


B. COMMODE (Style 51017)—A delightful miniature of a versatile piece of furniture. The commode could be used in a bedroom as a bedside table or to hold a bowl and pitcher. It could be used in a hall as a lamp table or even in the dining room as a side table. Marble top and brass hardware. 19th century. 2 1/2" h x 2" w x 1 1/2" d. **HOM Finished.** #896ME \$19.95

C. BEDSTEAD (Style 51013)
The Victorians loved massive furniture and the original of this miniature bedstead is typical of the ornately styled and decorated pieces of the era. 19th century. 7" h x 5" w x 7" d. Mattress included; cover and bolster not included. **HOM Finished.** #808ME \$75.00



D. WASHSTAND (Style 51018)—This was designed as a functional piece, with a shelf to hold a bowl-and-pitcher set and drawers for linen storage. The gracefully turned bars on either side are more than ornamentation — they serve as convenient towel racks. 19th century. 3 1/2" h x 3 3/4" w x 1 1/2" d. **HOM Finished.** #897ME \$24.95



E. WARDROBE (Style 51016)—Closet space was scarce, if it existed at all in Victorian homes. The family's clothing was stored in beautiful pieces of furniture such as this elegant miniature wardrobe with 1/2" socket feet, paneled doors, and elaborately trimmed top. 19th century. 8" h x 4" w x 1 1/2" d. **HOM Finished.** #898ME \$49.95



F. DRESSING CASE (Style 51014)—Three marble shelves and ornate finials distinguish this impressive miniature. Large and small drawers with brass hardware provide storage for garments and toiletries. 19th century. 7 1/4" h x 4" w x 2" d. **HOM Finished.** #899ME \$75.00



A. TALL CLOCK

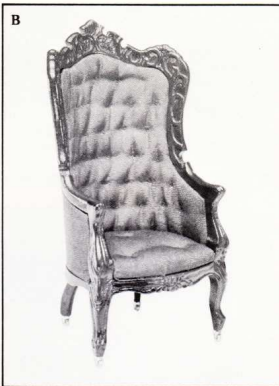
(Style 51006)—The intricately carved Victorian interpretation of a time piece style popular since the mid-17th century. The face features solid brass hands and both Roman and Arabic numerals. c. 1850-60. 7" h x 2" w x 1 1/4" d. **HOM Finished.** *996ME \$35.00



B. WING CHAIR

(Style 51004)—The velvet upholstery and darkly-stained wood match the sofa. In chairs such as these, the Victorian gentlemen found comfort at the end of the day. c. 1850-60. 4 1/8" h x 2 3/4" w x 2 3/4" d. **HOM Finished.***988ME \$40.00

D. ETAGERE (Style 51008)—An authentically detailed miniature of the massive original common to the era. Complete with intricate turned carvings and ornamentation, this piece grandly-displayed prized possessions. Deep forest green. c. 1850-60. 8 1/8" h x 5 1/2" w x 1 3/4" d. **HOM Finished.** *991ME \$100.00

C. CHIFFONIER

(Style 51015)—An elegant miniature chest of drawers, preserving the simple lines of the original. Dark-stained wood, so popular in the Victorian era, with graduated drawers and solid brass knobs. 19th century. 3 1/2" h x 3 3/4" w x 1 3/4" d. **HOM Finished.** *809ME \$24.95

E. PLANT STAND WITH REAL MARBLE TOP

A. UPHOLSTERED ROCKER
(Style 51007)—In forest-green velvet, has cabriole legs. A marvelous addition to parlor or bedroom. Also known as a sewing chair, it found additional use in soothing a fretful child. c. 1850-60. 27½" h x 1½" w x 2½" d. **HOM Finished.** #997ME \$25.00

C. PILLAR TABLE
(Style 51001)—A genuine marble top sits upon a lavishly carved central pillar. The curved legs and ornate detail typify the "Late Classical" style. c. 1830-40. 2½" h x 4¾" w x 4¾" d. **HOM Finished.** #990ME \$35.00

B. CORNER STAND (Style 51011)—An elaborately executed miniature, with five graduated shelves, to grace a corner and display tiny treasures. Each shelf is backed with a beautifully carved rim and supported by graceful turned spindles. c. 1850-60. 7" h x 2¼" w x 1½" d. **HOM Finished.** #998ME \$30.00

E. PIER MIRROR
(Style 51020)—Placed in a front hall, the original of this authentic miniature allowed the lady of the house to check her appearance before departing. Genuine marble shelf and solid brass ornamentation. c. 1800's. 7" h x 2¼" w x 1¼" d. **HOM Finished.** #900ME \$29.95
